## **NOTE TO USERS**

# NI PCI-4070 Reference Overlay

This document describes how to apply the NI PCI-4070 reference overlay to the PC chassis.

The reference overlay fits over the banana connectors of an installed NI PCI-4070 but actually adheres to the PC chassis itself. Complete the following steps to install the NI PCI-4070 and the reference overlay:



**Note** Only apply the reference overlay to the PC chassis *after* the NI PCI-4070 is installed.

- 1. Power off the PC and remove the cover.
- 2. Turn the PC on its side to more easily access the PCI slots.
- 3. Insert the NI PCI-4070 into an open PCI slot.
- 4. Secure the NI PCI-4070 with the screw provided.
- 5. Replace the PC cover.
- 6. Remove the protective backing from the reference overlay.




Figure 1. Positioning the Reference Overlay

- 7. Align the reference overlay over the banana connectors on the NI PCI-4070, as shown in Figure 1 below:

- 8. Lightly press the reference overlay to affix it to the PC chassis.
- 9. Return the PC to the upright position.
- 10. Power on the PC.
